Educational Facilities

Wattsburg Area School District is comprised of Greene Township, Greenfield Township, Venango Township, Amity Township, and Wattsburg Borough. As a suburban district, Wattsburg has advantages which include extensive parental involvement, small class size and a safe school environment. The district is committed to the academic, emotional and physical growth of its students.

The Board of Education has placed a technology infrastructure in all district schools in order to provide a resource-rich environment that supports active learning. Currently, the school district has a student/computer ratio of 2:1. Internet access is filtered by a state-of-the-art filtering system that is constantly updated. The district runs both Macintosh and Windows platforms. With the proper software, students can access their files and campus servers from home.
