

Wattsburg Area School District Graduation Requirements

All students must complete the courses prescribed in the chart below and demonstrate proficiency, as determined by WASD, in each of the state academic standards *not* assessed by a state assessment.

All Students must pass Algebra II and Geometry; this may require more than four math credits. Due to ECTS labs encompassing 12 elective credits, ECTS students require 3 credits in Science and Social Studies and 1 Physical Education credit. ECTS students are exempt from the Business Technology credits.

Additional Requirements by Class(es)

Class of 2019 and Beyond:

Students must either demonstrate proficiency (score in the Advanced or Proficient range) on the Algebra I, Literature, Biology, and Composition Keystone Exams or demonstrate proficiency on the corresponding Project Based Assessment in those areas if applicable.

Class of 2020 and Beyond:

Students must either demonstrate proficiency (score in the Advanced or Proficient range) on the Algebra I, Literature, Biology, Composition, and Civics & Government Keystone Exams or demonstrate proficiency on the corresponding Project Based Assessment in those areas if applicable.

Exceptions to Graduation Requirements

Students enrolled in a career and technical education program (Erie County Technical School) may demonstrate proficiency on a Keystone Exam or a Pennsylvania Skills Assessment (NOCTI) Exam to meet the requirement for testing in Composition and Civics & Government.

Special Education Students (IEP) are required to participate in the Keystone Exams as indicated for their peer cohort (class) group. Standards aligned goals may be substituted by the IEP team for each area assessed by a Project Based Assessment.
