Construction continues and summer promises to be busy. Northwest Tri-Dr. Pushchak shared that the Northwest Tri-County IU does not hold a County reorganization meeting like other school boards. IUs hold a mini convention Intermediate Unit instead. Dr. Pushchak was reelected as IU Board President at the mini convention. Dr. Pushchak also reported providing a welcome on behalf of the IU Board to the 350+ IU employees at the opening day of the IU In-service. There being no further business before the Board, upon motion by Mrs. Farrell, Adjournment seconded by Mrs. Burlingham, meeting was adjourned at 7:41 p.m.
