Scholarship Program Guidelines**

The MCA of Western Pennsylvania will recognize **four (4) outstanding students** by awarding each a scholarship. The **program winners will each receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship** a total of **four (4) scholarships will be awarded**. Recipients are well rounded individuals with deep interest and involvement in their communities. They spend time volunteering, have excellent academic performance, and are leaders in their schools through involvement in athletics, clubs, extra curricular activities and student government. They are the leaders of tomorrow.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must be accepted or enrolled in a two or four year program at an accredited college, university or Technical College for the 2024-2025 school year.
2. Applicants must be accepted or enrolled in a Plumbing, HVAC, Mechanical Engineering, Construction/Project Management, Architecture, or other Construction related major.
3. Applicants must currently be a resident of one of the following counties in Pennsylvania: Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Clarion, Crawford, Erie, Forest, Greene, Lawrence, McKean, Mercer, Venango, Warren, or Washington.
4. Scholarships are competitive and will be based upon:
 - a. A written essay, 500 words or less, on how Mechanical Contracting has improved the quality of life in Western Pennsylvania.
 - b. Academic standing of the student, notable academic awards and achievement.
 - c. Extracurricular activities, Volunteer activities, and Leadership.
 - d. Character reference.
5. Completed applications must be postmarked by **May 21, 2024** to be eligible for scholarships.
6. The Scholarship Committee will select 1st through 6th place finalists. The 5th and 6th place recipients will be deemed alternates. If for any reason the first through 4th place recipients become ineligible, then the alternates, according to finish, shall advance to receive the scholarship.
7. MCA of Western Pennsylvania reserves the right to disqualify entries not meeting the above criteria and reserves the right to change, revise or cancel the Scholarship awards after its announced intent to do so. The MCA of Western Pennsylvania reserves the right to waive any and all informalities in the award process.
